

Team Interpreting

This is a 5-week asynchronous online course in which we will discuss many aspects of working with a Team in Interpreting. Through the use of videos, articles and discussion boards we will explore why we need teams and what makes a good/bad team. You will have the opportunity to assess your own interpreting style and how you fit into a team, how you handle the support role, the active role, switching and more. Interpreting in the digital worlds has changed how and when we work with a team from embarrassing moments at home to protecting the privacy of our clients. We will also discuss our role in the CDI/Hearing interpreter team, pre-interpreting meetings and how to evaluate the experience afterward. This workshop is filled with questions to help you explore your role in the interpreting team.
